 The product is readily biodegradable and provides an alternative to alkylphenol ethoxylates (APEs) without the poor eco-toxicity profile of that class of surfactant

Storage and handling

Redicote E-95 may be stored in carbon steel tanks. Bulk stores need not be heated. Protect against exposure to moisture, which can gel the product. Redicote E-95 is a concentrated surfactant and is irritating to skin and eyes. Protective goggles and gloves must be worn when handling this product.
