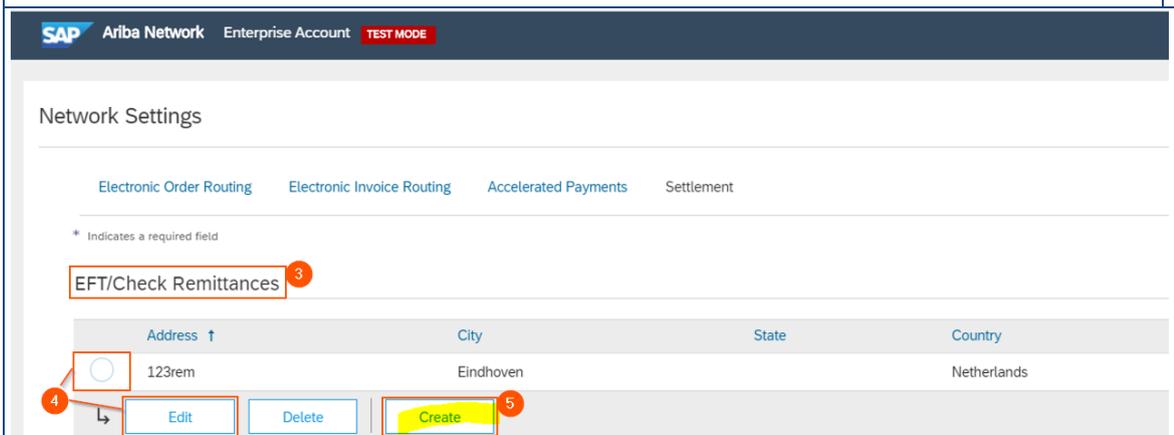
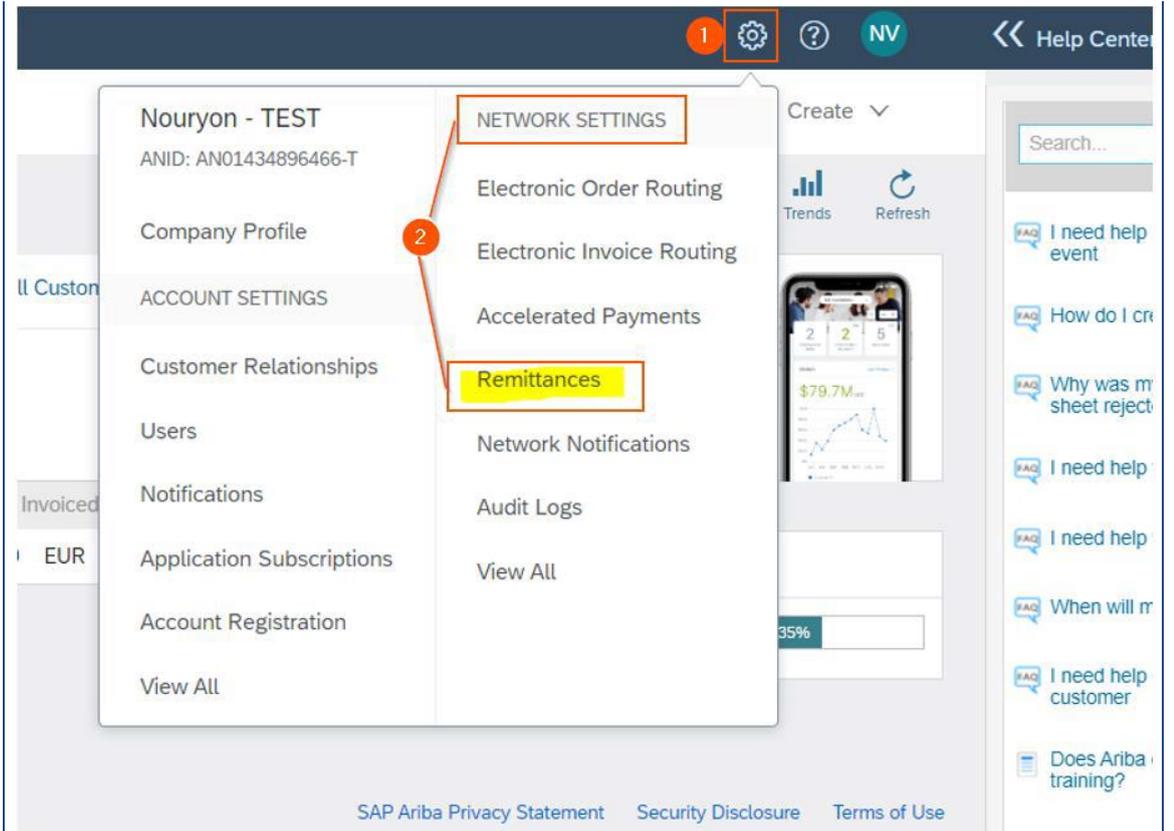

# How to include the IBAN value on your Electronic invoices (PO flip / SES flip)

## Including IBAN value in the main settings of your Ariba Network account

- 1 Click on the 'Settings' icon
- 2 Under 'Network Settings' go to 'Remittances'
- 3 Go to the section 'EFT/Check Remittances'
- 4 If there is already an address, tick the box and click 'Edit' to check if the IBAN information is already in place
- 5 If there is no address yet, click on 'Create' to
